Hard Surface Maintenance Contest Guidelines

Each contestant must demonstrate quality workmanship in maintaining a hard surface floor.

Each contestant will be required to prepare the floor by sweeping and removing any gum, if applicable and assembling equipment by putting the mop on the mop head, filling mop bucket and mixing chemicals. Contestant will then mop an area 10' X 12' using the cut-in method around the edges followed by using the Figure 8 pattern. The heel of the mop should always be on the floor. The contestant will use both sides of the mop to complete the area, checking for dry spots on the floor. Upon completion, contestant must empty and rinse the bucket and properly store equipment.

Each contestant will be provided the necessary equipment or components to complete the skill task to be judged in the contest, or the contestant may furnish his or her own equipment.

Each contestant will be provided the same project.

As soon as the contestant has completed the assignment and is fully satisfied with the project and workmanship, the contestant should signal the judge and stop work. This will determine the elapsed time and speed. The project will be judged on workmanship and operational techniques.

Contestants will be rated on the basis of total scores, including such things as accuracy, speed, acceptable procedure, workmanship and safety.

Maximum time allowed for mopping will be 10 minutes. There will be a 5 point penalty deducted for each minute over 10 minutes; so time will be a definite factor in determining winners.
