

SAMPLE AGENDA FOR JUDGES BRIEFING

8:30 a.m. Welcome

Distribute name badges

Complete Judges Information Sheet with complete address.

Special housekeeping instructions

NOTE: Remind judges they are working with students who are under pressure. They must be strict, but fair and consistent. This is a competition of student's existing skills. Judges should not assist students if he/she is having difficulty. If there is a problem with equipment, the host teacher should be contacted.

Who is authorized to be in contest area (i,e, no instructors)?

Make sure stations are properly prepared for next contestant.

Review Contest Problem(s)/Project(s)

Determine a tie breaker/PDP Test then???? (NOTE: Flipping a coin is not acceptable).

Review Rating Sheet

CONTEST RESULTS

Postsecondary and secondary students may compete together but scores are separated on contest result sheet.

Review importance of not confusing contestant numbers with 1st, 2nd and 3rd place rankings.

Recheck, recheck and recheck again additions on each judges rating sheet.

Recheck, recheck and recheck again the math on tabulation form. (Scoring mistakes is the most common mistake made at contest)
