

2023 Oklahoma Skills USA Criminal Justice Competition

The **Criminal Justice** Skills competition will be comprised of three parts.

- **Part one:** Online computer examination over basic Skills USA knowledge is taken by students before the contest date. The PD test will be 2.5% of the overall score.
- **Part two:** 25-question computer examination over basic patrol and search and seizure knowledge within the guidelines of the 4th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. Value: one point per correct answer. The written test will be 10% of the overall score.
- **Part three:** This four-station performance test comprised of a domestic violence call, report writing, low-risk traffic stop, and lifting latent fingerprints. Value: See individual station outlines for specific points per task. The performance test will be 87.5 % of the overall score.

The overall score will determine the winners of this competition. If there is a tie, then the judges will determine the tiebreaker.

The pre-contest briefing shall occur on Sunday, April 23, 2023, at the DoubleTree Hotel 2nd-floor ballroom. The remaining competition stations will be held on Monday, April 24, 2023, in the main Exhibit Hall.
