

Entrepreneurship State Contest Information

DATE, TIME and LOCATION

Note Contest Locations Change

A mandatory orientation will be held on **Sunday, April 23** at 4:00 p.m. in the **Remington** Room at the Downtown Doubletree Hotel, Tulsa. The Professional Development must be taken online from March 15 - April 7.

During the orientation, contestants will turn in 4 copies of their Business Plan and contestants will draw for positions (the order that they will compete). At the end of the orientation meeting each team will be given the challenge for the Challenge Presentation to be presented on Monday, April 24.

For the performance part of the contest, contestants will need to report to the **Remington** Room of the Tulsa Doubletree Hotel on **Monday, April 24th**. The contest will begin at 9:00 a.m. and students will remain in the holding area until after the contest is complete.

The performance part will consist of two rounds. During the first round each team will present their 12 Minute Business Plan Presentation. After all teams have performed the Business Plan Presentation the second round will begin. During the second round each team will present the 12-minute Challenge Presentation.

RULES and REGULATIONS

From this competition, we will select a secondary and postsecondary contestant to represent Oklahoma at the National SkillsUSA Championships in Louisville, KY. Therefore, we will follow the national rules and regulations and content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level. Any contestant winner who is not in official attire will not be permitted on stage but will be escorted behind the stage to receive his/her medallion.
