State Contest Information

Date, Time and Location of Contestant Meeting The 2023 State SkillsUSA Quiz Bowl Contest will be held on **Sunday, April 23** at the Tulsa Downtown Doubletree Hotel. **Secondary and Postsecondary** contestants need to report to the Holding Room (Manchester) at 12:00 noon. The secondary contest will be held in the Geneva Room and the postsecondary contest will be held in the Russell/Woodward Room.

Team Members A Quiz Bowl team consists of 4 or 5 team members all from the same school and from the same division (high school or postsecondary). Teams with 3 or less team members will be disqualified. Substitutions from the district qualifying competitions are allowed (maximum of 2) but ALL contestants must be registered with the State Office prior to the conference.

Competition schedule There will be two competition rooms. All high school and adult teams need to report to the holding room at 12:00 noon. The first round will begin at approximately 12:30 p.m. The top six teams will qualify for the final round. Both rounds will consist of 100 questions each. Instructors/Advisors will be able to attend the orientation meeting, however, only contestants may ask questions. Instructors will be asked to leave when the contest begins. **No observers will be allowed in the contest rooms.**

Contestant Resume All Quiz Bowl contestants will be required to submit a one page, typed resume. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.

Clothing Requirements

For men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.

For women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.

Men may also wear official SkillsUSA white polo shirt with black dress slacks, black socks and black leather shoes.

Women may also wear official SkillsUSA white polo shirt with black dress slacks or skirt, black socks or black or clear seamless hose and black leather shoes.

Awards Ceremony Contest winners will be recognized at the General Session on **Monday evening, April 24**, at 7:00 p.m. in the Tulsa Convention Center Grand Hall. Official SkillsUSA clothing requirements are as follows: "*For men:* SkillsUSA official attire: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks, white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA tie, black socks and black shoes. *For women:* Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks or skirt (knee length), with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black shoes."
