CONTEST FEES

In addition to the regular conference registration, there will be a contest supplies fee of **\$35.00 per contestant**. This charge is to offset the cost of contest supplies. This fee will be added to the contestant's registration when it is completed online.

DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION

Testing – The professional development and written exams will be given online from March 15 - April 7, 2023.

Skill Contest The 2023 State SkillsUSA Aviation Maintenance Technology Contest will be held on Monday, April 24th and will be hosted at Tulsa Technology Center - Riverside Campus, 801 E. 91st in Tulsa.

The contestant meeting will be held at on 8 AM the morning of the contest. Only calculators, safety glasses, pencils/pens, and earplugs will be allowed in the contestant meeting room. A locker will be provided to each school to store contestants' items (ie: bags, cell phones, etc.).

The contest will start promptly at 8:30 a.m.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from the contest site will not be available. Please make arrangements to provide your transportation to and from the contest site.

LUNCH

Due to the contest schedule, lunch will be provided and will take place at the contest site.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

As in the past, skill contestants will not be penalized for not adhering to national clothing requirements. Contestants should not wear clothing that has school identification visible to the judges. Those contestants wearing program uniforms will need to cover all identifying marks.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Contest winners will be recognized during the Awards Assembly on Tuesday, April 25th at the Tulsa Cox Convention Center in the Grand Hall at 9:00 a.m. Official SkillsUSA attire is required. According to the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards- official clothing requirements are as follows: "For men: SkillsUSA official attire: Official red blazer or jacket, black trousers, white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or official SkillsUSA tie, black socks, and black shoes. For women: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks or skirt, with a businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse e with a small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, black sheer or skin-tone hose and black dress shoes. **Any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire will not be permitted on stage.** The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion and awards.

INDUSTRY AWARDS

Industry awards should be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier so that an appropriate "Thank you" may be sent, must be accompanied by an *industry award donation information sheet* (available on the Oklahoma SkillsUSA website) and be brought to the **awards area in the Conference Hall** at the Tulsa Convention Center on Monday, April 24th, between 8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

From this competition, we will select a contestant to represent Oklahoma at the United States Skill Championships. Therefore, we will follow the national rules, regulations, and contest content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level.
