#### **Contestant Resumes**

All contestants will be required to submit a one-page typed resume at registration. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.

#### Date, Time, and Location

Registration, kit checks, color sketches, photos, descriptions, and resumes submitted from 3:00 -5:30 p.m. **Sunday, April 23,** in the Exhibit Hall contest area. Contestants' ID Badges will be handed out during registration.

Kit Check 3:00 - 5:00 p.m.

**Contestant Meeting 5:30 p.m. in the Convention Center Exhibit Hall** in the contest area. All contestants need to have their name badge with their contestant number with them.

**This orientation meeting is required of all contestants.** If a contestant misses this meeting, he/she is disqualified. If a contestant is involved in a leadership contest, and this creates a time conflict with the contestant meeting, the contest chair (of both contests) must be notified before the meeting so that arrangements can be made.

#### **Contestant Lunches**

- No other food will be permitted in the contest area unless prior arrangements have been made with the State Director or the Contest Chair.

The Professional Development and skill written tests will be given online <u>March 15 - April 7, 2023</u>. Models do not need to take the Professional Development or Written Technical test!

#### **General Guidelines for Cosmetology Contests**

 NO CELL PHONES will be allowed in the contestant area. Any contestant caught using a cell phone will be disqualified from the competition.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Each contestant must bring a power strip and a 12' 12-gauge extension cord.

The Cosmetology manikins will be Daisy (Burmax), Whitney (Burmax) and Sam II (Burmax). The Barbering manikins will be Ryan Deluxe Bearded (Burmax), Whitney (Burmax), and Dwayne (Burmax). The hair on the manikins will not be shampooed or conditioned. Students will be allowed to take manikins back to school with them.

The Long hair design manikin (Daisy) will be mailed or delivered to school before contest.

#### **Awards Ceremony**

Contest winners will be recognized at the Awards Assembly on <u>Tuesday morning, April 25</u> at 9:00 a.m. at the Tulsa Convention Center Ballroom. Official SkillsUSA attire is required! Skills USA Championships Technical Standards - official clothing requirements are as follows: "For men: SkillsUSA official attire: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks, white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA tie, black socks and black shoes. For women: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks or skirt (knee length), with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, black sheer or skin-tone hose and black shoes." Any contestant winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire will not be permitted on stage but will be escorted behind the stage to receive his/her medallion and awards. The awards ceremony is the "showplace" of our state conference, and many industry guests and VIPs are invited to present medallions and honor our students.

### Qualifying for Oklahoma State Skill Championships: Cosmetology, Barbering, Nail Care, and Esthetics Contest:

All Regions:

First, second, and third places in Secondary First and second places in Postsecondary:

#### **Purposes of Contests**

To evaluate students' skill preparation for employment in a barber or cosmetology-related field. To recognize outstanding students for their excellence and professionalism within barber or cosmetology programs.

**Clothing Committee** (selected by the contest chair and/or the trade group chair) will inspect clothing upon check-in on the day of the competition.

#### Eligibility

Active SkillsUSA members, secondary or postsecondary, enrolled in a career tech Basic Barber, Cosmetology, Nail Tech, or Esthetician program. NO STUDENT INSTRUCTORS or students returning for review hours are eligible as contestants, models, or judges. Students who have completed their program, passed state boards, and have worked in a salon for 3 months or less are eligible for competition.

#### **Grievances**

All complaints must be submitted in writing and addressed to the State SkillsUSA Director by the end of contest day, according to the official Grievance Policy.
