DATE, TIME and LOCATION

Note Contest Locations Change

The State Related Technical Math Contest will be held online. Students will receive a link to the test on March 15, 2023 and will need to complete the test with the school testing liaison by April 7, 2023.

RULES and REGULATIONS

The SkillsUSA (PDP) test will be taken on-line March 15-April 7. Instructors and testing liaisons will receive testing instructions. No provisions are being made for make-up testing on-site.

Please refer to the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards for guidelines.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Contestants MUST wear official SkillsUSA attire TO THE TEST. A clothing penalty will apply for any deviations from official dress.

According to the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards - official clothing requirements are as follows: "For men: SkillsUSA official attire: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks, white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA tie from the SkillsUSA store, black socks and black shoes.

For women: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks or skirt (knee length), with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black shoes."

EQUIPMENT and MATERIALS

Contestants will need to bring a calculator and they will have two hours to complete a 50 question test.

CONTESTANT RESUME

All contestants will be required to submit a one page, typed resume. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Contest winners will be recognized at the Awards Assembly on Tuesday morning during the General Session, **Tuesday**, **April 25**, at 9:00 a.m. in the Grand Hall at the Tulsa Convention Center. Official SkillsUSA attire is required!

Any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire will **not** be permitted on stage.
