Additional Contest Notes:

- Contest times are approximate; as we all know extra time often needs to be allowed for troubleshooting and/or possible printing problems.
- Make sure your students know how to save and export to pdf.
- Have your students bring a writing utensil to take notes during instruction
- Bring a clean flash drive as backup.
- Testing PDP and Ad Design written exams for state contests are taken online prior to the contest. You are responsible for contacting your school's testing liaison and scheduling your students.
- Transportation Transportation to and from the contest will NOT be provided.
- Internet will not be used during the contest
- Bring your computer, tablet if desired, 3-pronged extension cords, and art supplies. (ex. Pica pole, e-scale, colored pencils, markers, pen, pencil, highlighter, sketch paper)
- Contestants are NOT required to wear official SkillsUSA clothing during the contest but should NOT wear clothing with school identification.
