The State SkillsUSA Chapter Display contest will be held on Sunday, April 21, 2024 at the Cox Convention Center.

Clothing Requirements

Contestants must wear official SkillsUSA dress attire for contest. A clothing penalty will apply for any deviations from official dress. <u>Class A: SkillsUSA Official Attire</u>

Contestant Resume

All contestants will be required to submit a one page, typed resume. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.

Rules and Regulations

SkillsUSA (PDP) test will be taken on-line March 13-April 9. Students need to coordinate with testing centers on their campuses to complete testing.

We will follow the national rules and regulations and content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level. Official outline of contest found on SkillsUSA Chapter Display found/accessed through Absorb.

- Students who are setting up Displays must report to the Display Chairman at the Display area outside the Grand Hall on the first floor at the Tulsa Convention Center from 11:00 a.m. to 1 p.m. on **Sunday, April 21st**.
- <u>Students will have from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. to set up Displays</u>. Display set-up is limited to three students per entry (NO ADVISORS WILL BE ALLOWED!).
- Displays requiring electrical service must bring their own extension cords. Displays requiring tables will need to bring their own tables.

- <u>Judging will take place at 1:30 p.m.</u> One student for each Display must be present for an interview during the judging. All contestants will be required to submit a one page, typed resume. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.
- Displays will be left up for viewing on **Monday, April 22, 2024**.
- Students are encouraged to stay with displays to allow viewers to visit with them during 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Monday. *This is a great time to showcase the student's talent and an opportunity for students to talk about their school, instructor, program, and the skills.*
- Displays must be removed between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Monday. SkillsUSA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DISPLAYS WHICH ARE NOT PICKED UP BY 5:00 P.M. on Monday.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Contest winners will be recognized at the General Session on Monday evening, April 22, at 7:00 p.m. in the Tulsa Convention Center Grand Hall.

Contest winners will not be allowed on stage if not in official dress. For men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes. For women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.
