Contestant Resumes

Date, Time, and Location

Check-in and registration is from 3:00 -5:30 p.m. **Sunday, April 21**, in the Exhibit Hall contest area. Contestants' ID Badges will be handed out during registration.

Contestant Meeting 5:30 p.m. in the Convention Center Exhibit Hall in the contest area. All contestants must have their name badge and their contestant number.

Kit Check will be conducted morning of competition. Please have the contestants bring their kit, sketches, and/or written descriptions.

This orientation meeting is required of all contestants. If a contestant misses this meeting, **he/she is disqualified**. If a contestant is involved in a leadership contest, which creates a time conflict with the contestant meeting, the contest chair (of both contests) must be notified before the meeting to make arrangements.

- **No other food will be permitted in the contest area unless prior arrangements have been made with the State Director or the Contest Chair.**

General Guidelines for Cosmetology Contests

Within this document, you will find the **General Guidelines for all contests. Please read these guidelines carefully!!!!**

- **NO CELL PHONES will be allowed in the contestant area. Any contestant caught using a cell phone will be disqualified from the competition.**

PLEASE NOTE: Each contestant must bring a power strip and a 12' 12-gauge extension cord.

Manikins

The Cosmetology manikins will be Daisy (Burmax) for the long hair design, Whitney (Burmax), and Sam II (Burmax). The Barbering manikins will be Ryan Deluxe Bearded (Burmax), Jake (Burmax) and Dwayne (Burmax). The hair on the manikins will not be shampooed or conditioned. Students can take manikins back to school with them after the contest.

The Long hair design manikin (Daisy) will be mailed or delivered to school before the contest.

Awards Ceremony

Contest winners will be recognized at the Awards Assembly on Tuesday, April 23, at 9:00 a.m. at the Tulsa Convention Center Ballroom. **Official SkillsUSA attire is required!** Skills USA Championships Technical Standards - official clothing requirements are as follows: "**For men:** SkillsUSA official attire: Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks, white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA tie, and black shoes. **For women:** Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks or skirt (knee length), with a business-like white or white polo, and black shoes." Any contestant winner not in official SkillsUSA attire **will not be permitted on stage** but will be escorted behind the stage to receive their medallion and awards. The awards ceremony is the "showplace" of our state conference, and many industry guests and VIPs are invited to present medallions and honor our students.

Qualifying for Oklahoma State Skill Championships: Cosmetology, Barbering, Nail Care, and Esthetics Contest:

All Regions:

First, second, and third places in Secondary

First and second places in Postsecondary

Clothing Committee (selected by the contest chair and/or the trade group chair) will inspect clothing upon check-in on the day of the competition.

Eligibility

Active SkillsUSA members, secondary or postsecondary, enrolled in a Career Tech Barber, Cosmetology, Nail Tech, or Esthetician program. **NO STUDENT INSTRUCTORS or students returning for review hours are eligible as contestants, models, or judges.** **Students who have completed their program, passed state boards, and have worked in a salon for three months or less are eligible for competition.**

Grievances

According to the official Grievance Policy, all complaints must be submitted in writing and addressed to the State SkillsUSA Director by the end of contest day.
