

2024 Photography State Contest Information

Schedule

Judges will give a theme to the contestants on the day of the contest, and students will follow the theme during the location shoot.

Students will arrive at the Owasso campus, and we will bus students to a nearby neutral site.

Contestants will need to bring their own computers to edit their location shoot.

Contestants won't be printing out their day of contest theme image; they save that image to a provided USB flash drive to submit.

(NEW FOR 2024)

THEME FOR SUBMITTED IMAGE: Portrait

New for this year the submitted 8x10 printed image needs to be a portrait.

The contestants need to bring **ONE** printed 8x10 photo with them to be submitted and judged (contestant number on the back of them) **(these should not be mounted in any way)**.

Points will be deducted if mounted in any way.

IMPORTANT as several students did not know how to do this in years past

Contestants need to know how to make an electronic contact sheet or sheet of thumbnails of their theme shoot to be submitted electronically to be judged for points.

Contestants need to bring a résumé.

(judges will judge theme image during this time)

Point Breakdown

Submitted image 500

(this is the 8x10 print portrait submitted image brought on day of contest)

Theme image 300

(live shoot on day of contest, the theme will be given by the judges on day of shoot)

Written test 100

Contact sheet 100

(IMPORTANT as several students did not know how to do this in years past. Contestants need to know how to make an electronic contact sheet or sheet of thumbnails of their theme shoot to be submitted electronically to be judged for points.)

Resume -10

Students will submit their up-to-date résumé. If a résumé is not provided, there will be a 10-point penalty.
