## **Awards Ceremony**

Contest winners will be recognized during the Awards Assembly at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 in the Tulsa Convention Center. Official SkillsUSA attire is required. Any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire will not be permitted on stage. The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion and awards. The awards ceremony is the **"Showcase"** of our state conference and many industry guests and VIPs are invited to present medallions and honor our students. **NO HATS ARE TO BE WORN DURING THE AWARDS CEREMONY**

## **Clothing Requirements**

On the day of the skills competition, all students will be required to wear appropriate clothing representative of their occupation.

## **Industry Awards**

All industry awards should be clearly marked so that they will not get mixed up with other contests. Industry awards need to be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier and taken to the contest chair the day of the skill contest. Industry awards need to be coordinated through the contest chair and properly labeled as secondary or post-secondary. **ALL INSTRUCTORS PARTICIPATING IN THE STATE CONTEST SHOULD BRING AT LEAST TWO INDUSTRY AWARDS PER REGISTERED CONTESTANT.**

## **PERFORMANCE**

**Contestants will have a time limit of 90 minutes to create the following 3 designs and flowers will be provided for a 1 dozen arranged roses in a vase, a hand tied bouquet and 1 corsage. These will be judged by the florists in the industry.**

## **IDENTIFICATION**

35 Cut Flower and Foliage's from the approved list provided in the Floral Design Contest Information Study Guide

15 Blooming and Interior Foliage plants from the approved list provided in the Floral Design Contest Information Study Guide

Each Cut Flower, Foliage, Blooming Plant and Interior Foliage Plant will be worth 2 points each.

## **SkillsUSA**

### **Floral Design Contest Rules**

#### **READ EACH ITEM CAREFULLY!**

- All students competing must be paid SkillsUSA members.
- Official SkillsUSA wear is not required, but students are to be dressed in a professional manner.
- The purpose of the contest is to promote the development of basic skills in the floral industry.
- Contestants will be known by number only, no reference to school or personal name is allowed.
- Contestants will need to supply their own hand tools. Flowers, foliage's and containers will be provided by the OSFA or Oklahoma State Floral Association.
- All work is to be done by the individual contestant. Nothing is to be pre-made. There is to be no talking while contest is taking place.
- Judges will be leading professionals in the floral design field.
- The Floral Design General Knowledge and PDP Knowledge Tests will be taken online March/April. These will be multiple choice tests and will test the basic knowledge of the principles of floriculture (floral design) and the Skills USA organization. The floral design general knowledge will be 50 questions from the 100 question Floral Design General Knowledge Study Guide.
- The Identification Contest will have two (2) parts:
  - Cut Flower and Foliage
  - Flowering and Interior Foliage Plants

Contest will be multiple choices from the identification Study Guide provided with this contest.

There will be a \$85.00 cost for Supplies and Certification.

All contestants will take the Online Written Floral Assistant Test.
