

2024 State SkillsUSA TeamWorks Contest

Tentative-Information is subject to change, check back often.

Item 1 – Date, Time and Location

The Professional Development (PDP) written test will be given online from Mar 13 - Apr 9, 2024.

Contest Chairman will pick up contest box on Saturday, April 20th, 2024.

Contest setup will be from 12:00-3:00p.m. Saturday April 20th, 2024, and all contestant tools and materials will need to be unloaded into the convention center contest area at this time.

The 2024 State SkillsUSA TeamWorks contest will begin the evening of Saturday, April 20, 2024, starting with team presentations from 5:00 -7:00 p.m. (**Remington Room at the Double Tree**). The orientation for presentation judges will be at 4:30 p.m. The skills portion of the contest begins on April 21st, 2024. Contestant orientation will begin promptly at 6:45 a.m. in the Tulsa Convention Center TeamWorks contest area. Day two of competition will be held on April 22nd in the same location.

On April 22, 2024, contest chair and judges will need to report to the Tulsa Convention Center at 8:00 a.m. to prepare for contestant briefing.

On Sunday, April 21st Crossland Construction will conduct a tour of the construction site across the street from the Cox Center at 5:00 p.m.be prepared to bring a hard hat.

On Sunday, April 21st a meal sponsored by AGC Oklahoma Education Foundation and the Tulsa Homebuilder's Association will be held from 6:00-7:30 p.m. at Baxter's Grill ,717 S Houston Ste 100, Tulsa, OK 74127

On Monday April 22nd, 2024, there will be a meeting and breakfast from 6:45 – 8:00 a.m. in the Aaronson room at the Tulsa Public Library East of the Convention Center. Contestant resumes will be collected at the Cox Convention center after the meeting.

All contestants are required to submit a one-page, typed resume. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.

Item 2 – Lunch

Be prepared to purchase lunch for both days of the competition. (There might be donations to take care of meals but still be prepared if this does not take place.)

Item 3 – Rules and Regulations

From this competition, a secondary and post-secondary team will be selected to represent Oklahoma at the National SkillsUSA competition. Therefore, we will follow the national rules, regulations, and contest content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level. All contestants will be required to assist in the cleanup following the judging.

Item 4 – Clothing Requirements

April 21-22, 2024, the days of the skills competition, all students will be required to wear appropriate clothing representative of their occupation. Hard hats and safety glasses are always required while in the contest area.

Item 5 – Industry Awards

All TeamWorks industry awards should be clearly marked so that they will not be mixed up with the carpentry and cabinetmaking contests. Industry awards need to be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier and taken to the Industry Awards check-in at the Tulsa Convention Center Arena on Monday, April 22, 2024. **ALL INSTRUCTORS PARTICIPATING IN THE STATE CONTEST SHOULD BRING AT LEAST ONE INDUSTRY AWARDS PER REGISTERED CONTESTANT.**

Item 6 – Awards Ceremony

Contest winners will be recognized during the Awards Assembly at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2024, in the Tulsa Convention Center Arena. **OFFICIAL SkillsUSA ATTIRE IS REQUIRED!** Any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire **will not** be permitted on stage. The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion or certificate and/or awards. The awards ceremony is the “**Showcase**” of our state conference, and many industry guests and VIPs are invited to present medallions and honor our students. **NO HATS ARE TO BE WORN DURING THE AWARDS CEREMONY.**
