Rules and Regulations

For this competition, a secondary and post-secondary contestant will be selected to represent Oklahoma at the National SkillsUSA competition in Atlanta. Therefore, we will follow the national rules, regulations, and contest content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level.

Clothing Requirements

April 11th, the day of the skills competition, all students will be required to wear appropriate clothing representative of their occupation. No logos or wording is allowed on your clothing that will identify you or your school. <u>Safety glasses</u>, <u>hard hats</u>, <u>safety vests</u>, <u>jeans</u>, <u>and work boots</u> <u>are required at all times while in the contest area.</u>

Contest winners will be recognized during the Awards Assembly at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23rd in the Tulsa Convention Center Arena. <u>OFFICIAL SkillsUSA ATTIRE IS REQUIRED!</u> According to the <u>SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards</u> – clothing requirements. Any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire <u>will not</u> be permitted on stage. The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion and/or awards. The awards ceremony is the "Showcase" of our state conference, and many industry guests and VIPs are invited to present medallions and honor our students. NO HATS ARE TO BE WORN DURING THE AWARDS CEREMONY.

ONLY THE FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD PLACE WINNERS WILL BE GOING ON THE STAGE. This will mirror what takes place during the National SkillsUSA Awards Ceremony. They will need to be wearing their conference name badge in order to be permitted into the awards area to pick up their industry awards/prizes.

No industry prizes/awards will be given to the $4^{th} - 6^{th}$ places from this time forward.
