CONTEST

Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and the contest will start promptly at 8:30 a.m.

DRESS CODE

Contestants are required to wear closed toed, closed heel shoes during the contests. Students are not allowed to wear any clothing that identifies them by name or displays their school names/likeness.

INDUSTRY AWARDS

Each participating school is expected to furnish an industry award. Industry awards should be labeled and be brought to OCCC the day of contest and turned in at contest registration. Prizes will be brought to the Tulsa Convention Center on Monday, April 22nd, on behalf of the contest.
