



Quiz Bowl State Contest Memo

Date, Time and Location of Contestant Meeting

The 2023 State SkillsUSA Quiz Bowl Contest will be held on **Sunday, April 21st** at the Tulsa Downtown Doubletree Hotel. Contestants need to report to the holding room at 12:00 noon.

Competition schedule

There will be two competition rooms. Contestants will be directed to their contest rooms after check-in. The first round will begin at approximately 12:30 p.m. Instructors/Advisors will be able to attend the orientation meeting, however, only contestants may ask questions. Instructors will be asked to leave when the contest begins. **No observers will be allowed in the contest rooms.**

Clothing Requirements

Contestants will wear official SkillsUSA dress attire for contest. A clothing penalty will apply for deviations from official dress. Official dress for contest can be Class A: SkillsUSA Official Attire or Class E: Competition Specific — Business Casual

Contestant Resume

All contestants will be required to submit a one page, typed resume. If any contestant does not submit a resume to the contest chair, penalty points will be assessed.

Rules and Regulations

Testing will be taken on-line March 13-April 9. Students need to coordinate with testing centers on their campuses to complete testing. Substitutions will close April 5th.

Awards Ceremony

Contest winners will be recognized at the General Session on Monday, April 22nd, at 7p.m. in the Tulsa Convention Center Grand Hall. Contest winners will not be allowed on stage if not in official dress.

For men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.

For women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.
