Date, Time and Location

All Job Readiness skill contests, Building Maintenance and Mechanical contests will be held at Tulsa Technology Center – Lemley Campus on Monday April 28th and will begin at 8:00 a.m.

All Job Readiness leadership contests (Job Interview, Prepared Speech and Financial Fitness) will be held on Sunday, April 27th at the Arvest Convention Center (formally the Cox Convention Center) starting at 12pm.

<u>Job Readiness contestants will be required to submit a resume</u>, All contestants that do not submit a resume to the contest chair will have penalty points assessed.

Transportation

All instructors will need to make arrangements for transporting their students to and from the contest site.

Testing for all students

Contestants will take the Professional Development test over SkillsUSA knowledge. The test will only be used as a tie breaker if the situation arises and is needed for the contest tie. Testing will be completed online and proctored through their technology centers. Online testing opens March 14, 2025, and closes Apil 4, 2025.

Contests that require a knowledge exam will take it on paper at the technology centers in their testing centers. (Not all of the Job Readiness contests will have required written testing).

Competitors who are not dressed appropriately or lack official attire will be denied access to the awards stage. Students must be present when their contest is announced. If a student is improperly dressed, absent, or misses their contest being called, the production will not be paused for any reason, and they will forfeit their opportunity to go on stage to receive the award. **No exceptions will be made**. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on stage.

Official dress for men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.

• Official dress for women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes

The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion and awards. The awards ceremony is the "Showcase" of our state conference and many industry guests and VIP's are invited to present medallions and honor our students.
