Date, Time and Location

The 2025 State SkillsUSA TeamWorks contest will start Saturday April 26th, 2025, with team presentations from 5:00 -7:00 p.m., Remington Room at the Double Tree.

Orientation for presentation judges will be at 4:30 p.m.

Contest set up

Contest setup will be from 12:00-3:00p.m. Saturday, April 26, 2024, and all contestant tools and materials will need to be unloaded into the convention center contest area at this time.

Contest

The skills portion of the contest being held on April 27th, 2025. Contestant orientation will begin promptly at 6:45 a.m. in TeamWorks contest area on April 27th, 2025 in the Exhibit Hall.

On April 27th, 2024, contest chair and judges will need to report to the Tulsa Convention Center at 8:00 a.m. to prepare for contestant briefing.

- Monday April 28th, 2025, there will be a meeting and breakfast from 6:45am – 8:00 a.m. in the Aaronson room at the Tulsa Central Library East of the Arvest Convention Center which is also being sponsored by the Tulsa Homebuilders Association and AGC Oklahoma.

All contestants will submit a digital resume prior to contest day. Contestants will receive an email to the address used to register the contestant for contest with instructions and

link to access the SkillsUSA Competitor Portal page. The email will contain contestant's username and contestant number, which are required to login to the Competitor Portal. **Deadline to submit resume is April 22, 2025.** If any contestant does not submit a resume penalty point will be assessed.

Lunch

Be prepared to purchase lunch for both days of the competition, the convention center will have light concession on Sunday and Monday. (There might be donations to take care of meals but still be prepared if this does not take place.)

Rules and Regulations

We will follow the national rules, regulations, and contest content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level. All contestants will be required to assist in the cleanup following the judging.

Clothing Requirements

April 27-28th, 2025, the days of the skills competition, all students will be required to wear appropriate clothing representative of their occupation. Hard hats and safety glasses are always required while in the contest area. No school logos or anything that shows your name allowed on clothing.

On Tuesday, April 29th, 2025, during the awards ceremony, all contestants are required to wear the Official SkillsUSA attire.

Industry Awards

Prizes are the responsibility of the individual contests. Prizes are not guaranteed and are not supplied at the SkillsUSA Oklahoma state level.

All TeamWorks industry awards should be clearly marked so that they will not be mixed up with the carpentry and cabinetmaking contests. Industry awards need to be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier and taken to the Industry Awards.

Please bring prizes to the industry awards area at the Arvest Convention Center Conference Hall, Sunday, April 27th between 12-4pm or Monday, April 28th between 8am-4pm.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Winners will be recognized at the General Session on Tuesday morning, April 29th, at 9am at the Arvest Convention Center in the Grand Hall. All competitors must wear official SkillsUSA dress to the Awards Session, where winners are announced. Competitors who are not dressed appropriately or lack official attire will be denied access to the awards stage. Students must be present when their contest is announced. If a student is improperly dressed, absent, or misses their

contest being called, the production will not be paused for any reason, and they will forfeit their opportunity to go on stage to receive the award. No exceptions will be made. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on stage.

- Official dress for men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
- Official dress for women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.
