The 2025 State SkillsUSA Mobile Electronics Installer Contest will be held on April 17th. The contest will be held at Meridian Tech – Stillwater (1312 S Sangre Rd, Stillwater, OK 74074). See attached map. Enter at Entrance #2. Contest will be held in the IDC Building; it is the first building on the left when you enter the campus. Park in Parking Lot D. Use the south door to enter the building.

CONTEST FEES

In addition to the regular conference registration a contest registration fee of \$35.00 and a one-time contest supplies fee of \$45.00 will be applied. This fee is to offset the cost of new competition materials purchased for this year only. It will be added to the contestant's registration during the online registration process.

SETUP

April 16th, 2025 at Meridian Tech – Stillwater (1312 S Sangre Rd, Stillwater, OK 74074).

CONTEST

Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and the contest will start promptly at 8:30 a.m.

TESTING

Contestants will be judged on their SkillsUSA knowledge through the Professional Development test and knowledge test. Testing will be completed online and proctored through their technology centers. Online testing opens March 14, 2025, and closes April 4, 2025. No provisions are being made for make-up testing on-site.

RESUME-

Due to the nature of the contest being a week prior to SLSC please bring resume to contest in person as a paper copy as normal. ****All contestants will still receive the email about a competitor portal, because we can not stop the batch emails from nationals, but will not be punished for not turning in digital resume. Please ignore resume email for this contest. Students must turn in resume at contest and no resumes will be accepted after the contest date.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Winners will be recognized at the General Session on Tuesday morning, April 29th, at 9am at the Arvest Convention Center in the Grand Hall. All competitors must wear official SkillsUSA dress to the Awards Session, where winners are announced. Competitors who are not dressed appropriately or lack official attire will be denied access to the awards stage. Students must be present when their contest is announced. If a student is improperly dressed, absent, or misses their contest being called, the production will not be paused for any reason, and they will forfeit their opportunity to go on stage to

receive the award. No exceptions will be made. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on stage.

- Official dress for men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
- Official dress for women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.

Industry awards should be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier so that an appropriate "Thank you" may be sent, must be accompanied by an *industry award donation information sheet* (available on the Oklahoma SkillsUSA website) and be brought to the **awards area in the Conference Hall** at the Arvest Business (formerly Cox) Center on **April 27th between 12:00 & 4:00 or April 28th 2025 between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 PM.**
