Extra=power strip

- a. Cutting shears

- a. Mirror and table
- b. All pictures or literature of styles, haircuts and creative instruction details related to the competition's tasks. **Note:** Pictures will not be provided until competition time.
- c. Competition creative design theme.

2. Supplied by the competitor (checked during kit check):

- a. Cutting shears
- b. Thinning shears
- c. Razor and spare blade
- d. Clipper (detachable metal blades are to be used unless otherwise noted)
- e. Trimmer
- f. Blow dryer
- g. Comb(s)
- h. Brush(es)
- i. Spray bottle filled with water
- j. Professional temporary hair color of choice: examples include pencils, chalks, spray, or hair paint. Any type of temporary color not requiring water to rinse is acceptable.

Esthetics KIT CHECK 2025 Oklahoma SkillsUSA SLSC

Supplied by the technical committee will be a workstation consisting of the following:

- a. Facial bed/table
- b. Chair (for model)
- c. Small table for products
- d. Towel steamers
- e. Water

SUPPLIED BY COMPETITOR

- a. A model is required and must be an active SkillsUSA student member. Models must register as a “participant” and are not required to take any test(s) or submit a resume.
- b. A written description of the theme for the fantasy makeup portion of the competition. This written description is limited to one page that is typewritten in a legible font and contained within a plastic sleeve. The description must be submitted at the competition orientation. A penalty of 10 points will be assessed for failure to comply.
- c. One 8"x10" color photograph of the completed competitor work of the fantasy makeup. The photograph must be submitted at orientation in a plastic sleeve. A **penalty** of 10 points will be assessed for failure to comply.
- d. Portable kit organizer (to transport and store items needed during the competition).
- e. All items necessary for a daytime beauty makeup application
- f. All items necessary for fantasy makeup application. A **penalty** of 10 points will be assessed for failure to comply.
- g. All necessary product applicators of the competitor’s choice, such as: Spatulas
Cotton swabs
Fan and mask brushes
Cotton 4"x4" pads or sponges
Tissues
Mascara wand
Makeup brushes (All applicators must be disposable or sanitized.)

All items necessary for basic facial and massage skills which include:

- 1. Cleanser
 - 2. Toner
 - 3. Moisturizer
 - 4. Exfoliator
 - 5. Mask
 - 6. Massage cream
- h. Competitors must bring a minimum of six (6) clean, white terry cloth towels in standard salon size (no holes or stains). Competitors will donate two towels to the competition to put in the hot towel steamer.
 - i. Headband
 - j. Proper draping supplies (cape for makeup application, two clean white sheets, twin-size sheet for massage and facial skills)

- k. Sealable plastic bags for sanitation and soiled linens
- l. Latex-free gloves (at least two pairs)
- m. Paper towels or tissues (can be mini travel size)
- n. Decontamination supplies for equipment and implements (must be EPA approved), e.g., (but not limited to) Barbicide, Ultracide
- o. Decontamination supplies for hands (e.g., hand sanitizer)
- p. Stainless steel bowl for water (1½ quart minimum size)
- q. First aid kit, including properly labeled blood spill sealable bag.

Nail Care KIT CHECK 2025 Oklahoma SkillsUSA SLSC

Supplied by the technical committee:

- a. Implement Disinfection Station
- b. Technical guidelines for the specific applications required to be performed
- c. Plastic bags for disposal of refuse
- d. Power outlet

Supplied by the competitor:

EXTRA POWER STRIP

- a. A model is required and must be an active SkillsUSA student member. Models must register as a “participant” and are not required to take any test(s) or submit a resume.
- b. White terry towels (no holes or stains allowed)
- c. Disposable towels for the table
- f. All items necessary to complete five (5) sculptured acrylic nails. **Note:** Dappen dishes must have covers; monomer, polymer, and primer must be from the same manufacturer; two or more of the four basic acrylic colors (pink, white, clear, or natural) must be used to complete two-tone/French manicure sculpted nails
- g. All items necessary to complete five (5) nails with a tip and light-cured enhancement overlay. Can be a hard gel or a hybrid gel/acrylic product. Light-cured enhancement product must be translucent. **Note:** Gel polish, temporary or no-light gels may not be used.
- h. Dark red crème lacquer/polish
- i. Items allowed for the flat nail art application include:
 - 1). Acrylic paints, polishes/lacquers, colored powders (acrylic and dip), gel polish, rhinestones sizes 20ss and under, glitters and dusts, and adhesives, i.e., gel topcoats/glue **Note:** No pre-prepared items can be used; items are limited to those intended for use on nails.
 - 2). A topcoat may be used as a sealer.
- j. A written description of the nail art theme. Themes are to be typewritten, should include pictures and be contained within a plastic sheet protector.
- k. Portable kit organizer (to transport all items necessary for the competition)
- l. All implements and tools should be brought to the competition clean and/or new and ready for use.
- m. Safety glasses, gloves and masks are optional.
- n. Manicure table lamp and 6' multi-outlet power strip (optional/suggested)
