## **Item 1 – Date, Time and Location**

The Professional Development (PDP) written test will be given online from Mar 16 - Apr 3, 2026.

Contest Chairman will pick up contest box at the Doubletree Hotel on Saturday April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

The 2026 State SkillsUSA TeamWorks contest will be held from the evening of Saturday April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026, starting with team presentations from 5:00 -7:00 p.m. (**Remington Room at the Double Tree**). Orientation for presentation judges will be at 4:30 p.m. The skills portion of the contest being held on April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Contestant orientation will begin promptly at 6:45 a.m. in the Arvest Convention Center TeamWorks contest area on April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Contest setup will be from 12:00-3:00p.m. Saturday April 18, 2026, and all contestant tools and materials will need to be unloaded into the convention center contest area at this time.

On April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026, contest chair and judges will need to report to the Tulsa Convention Center at 8:00 a.m. to prepare for contestant briefing.

## **RESUME**

All contestants will submit a digital resume prior to contest day. Contestants will receive an email to the address used to register the contestant for contest with instructions and link to access the SkillsUSA Competitor Portal page. The email will contain contestant's username and contestant number, which are required to login to the Competitor Portal.

### **Item 2 – Lunch**

Be prepared to purchase lunch for both days of the competition. (There might be donations to take care of meals but still be prepared if this does not take place.)

### **Item 3 – Rules and Regulations**

From this competition, a secondary and post-secondary team will be selected to represent Oklahoma at the National SkillsUSA competition in Louisville. Therefore, we will follow the national rules, regulations, and contest content as closely as possible. We want our contestants to be prepared to compete at the national level. All contestants will be required to assist in the cleanup following the judging.

### **Item 4 – Clothing Requirements**

April 19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>, 2026, the days of the skills competition, all students will be required to wear appropriate clothing representative of their occupation. Hard hats and safety glasses are always required while in the contest area.

On Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026, during the awards ceremony, all contestants are required to wear the Official SkillsUSA attire.

### **Item 5 – Industry Awards**

All TeamWorks industry awards should be clearly marked so that they will not be mixed up with the carpentry and cabinetmaking contests. Industry awards need to be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier. **Please bring prizes to the awards area at the Arvest Convention Center Tulsa Ballroom on Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup> between 12-4pm or Monday, April 20<sup>th</sup> between 8am-4pm. ALL INSTRUCTORS PARTICIPATING IN THE STATE CONTEST SHOULD BRING AT LEAST ONE INDUSTRY AWARDS PER REGISTERED CONTESTANT.**

## **Item 6 – Awards Ceremony**

Contest winners will be recognized during the Awards Assembly at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026, in the Tulsa Convention Center Arena. **OFFICIAL SkillsUSA ATTIRE IS REQUIRED!** Any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire **will not** be permitted on stage. The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion or certificate and/or awards. The awards ceremony is the “**Showcase**” of our state conference, and many industry guests and VIPs are invited to present medallions and honor our students. **NO HATS ARE TO BE WORN DURING THE AWARDS CEREMONY.**

- Official dress for men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
- Official dress for women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.
