The 2026 State SkillsUSA Mobile Electronics Installer Contest will be held on April 6th, 2026. The contest will be held at Meridian Technology Center – Stillwater (1312 S Sangre Rd, Stillwater, OK 74074). See attached map. Enter at Entrance #2. Contest will be held in the IDC Building; it is the first building on the left when you enter the campus. Park in Parking Lot D. Use the south door to enter the building.

CONTEST FEES

No additional fees this year aside from the regular conference registration of \$35.00

SETUP

April 3rd, 2026, at Meridian Tech – Stillwater (1312 S Sangre Rd, Stillwater, OK 74074).

CONTEST

Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and the contest will start promptly at 8:30 a.m.

TESTING

Contestants will be judged on their SkillsUSA knowledge through the Professional Development test and knowledge test. Testing will be completed online and proctored through their technology centers. Online testing opens March 16th, 2026, and closes April 3rd, 2026. No provisions are being made for make-up testing on-site.

RESUME-

All contestants will submit a digital resume prior to contest day. No resumes will be accepted on site. Contestants will receive an email to the address used to register the contestant for contest with instructions and link to access the SkillsUSA Competitor Portal page. The email will contain contestant's username and contestant number, which are required to login to the Competitor Portal. **The deadline to submit resumes is April 3rd, 2026.**

AWARDS CEREMONY

The top 5 contestants will be announced before the awards ceremony. Winners will be recognized at the General Session on Tuesday morning, April 21st, 2026 at the Arvest Convention Center in the Grand Hall. All competitors must wear official SkillsUSA dress to the Awards Session, where winners are announced. Competitors who are not dressed appropriately or lack official attire will be denied access to the awards stage.

Students must be present when their contest is announced. If a student is improperly dressed, absent, or misses their contest being called, the production will not be paused for any reason, and they will forfeit their opportunity to go on stage to receive the award. No exceptions will be made. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on stage.

- **Official dress for men:** Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and **completely black dress shoes.**
- **Official dress for women:** Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and **completely black dress shoes.**

INDUSTRY AWARDS

Industry awards should be labeled with the name and address of the award supplier so that an appropriate "Thank you" may be sent, must be accompanied by an *industry award donation information sheet* (available on the Oklahoma SkillsUSA website) and be brought to the **awards area in the Conference Hall** at the Arvest Business (formerly Cox) Center on **April 19th between 12:00 & 4:00 or April 20th 2026 between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 PM.**
