The 2026 Oklahoma SkillsUSA **Graphic Image Sublimation** will be held on **April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026** and will be hosted at the **CVTech El Reno Campus, Graphic Design Classrooms**

### **CONTEST**

It is the students' responsibility to be prepared to sublimate the materials that are made available to them for the competition. The sublimation room and equipment at CVTech El Reno will be available for instructors and their students upon request. The hosting instructor will not give an overview of the equipment or tools on the day of the competition; however, all questions will be answered in detail. Any equipment in the CVTech production/design area is available for all students. If you prefer to bring your own equipment, please do so. We will do our best to ensure it gets back home with you.

#### Items being sublimated

Metal- License Plate Frame and Aluminum Strip

Ceramic- Square/ Diamond Porcelain Ornament with string - *Double-sided*

Plastic- Round Bag Tag and Loop - *Double-sided*

Textile- Socks - *Double-sided*

Multiples- Coasters for Photoshop

FYI: There will be more than one double-sided

Photoshop: students will create pieces similar to previous years, but instead of using tiles, we will be sublimating four Coasters at one time. *The Coasters section, Multiples*. A template will be provided for guidance, and their custom design must fit within this template. One design will be spread across four pieces, as in previous years.

## CONTEST TESTING

Contestants will be judged on their SkillsUSA knowledge through the Professional Development test and a knowledge test based on their contest area, unless otherwise stated in the state memo. Testing will be completed online and proctored through their technology centers. Online testing opens March 16<sup>th</sup> and closes April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

## AWARDS CEREMONY

Winners will be recognized at the General Session on Tuesday morning, April 21st, at 9 am

**All competitors must wear the official SkillsUSA dress to the Awards Session, where winners are announced. Competitors who are not dressed appropriately or lack official attire will be denied access to the awards stage. Students must be present when their contest is announced. If a student is improperly dressed, absent, or misses their contest being called, the production will not be paused for any reason, and they will forfeit their opportunity to go on stage to receive the award. No exceptions will be made. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed on stage.**

- Official dress for men: Official blazer, jacket, or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
- Official dress for women: Official blazer, jacket, or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business-like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.

## **TOOLS AND SUPPLIES**

- Resumes will be uploaded to the competitor portal when testing. Do not bring your resume to the contest.

### Each School will provide the following:

- The sublimation room and equipment at CVTech El Reno will be available upon request for instructors and their students to practice.
- The hosting instructor will not give an overview of the equipment or tools on the day of the competition; however, all questions will be answered in detail.
- Any equipment in the CVTech production room is available for all students.
- If you prefer to bring your own equipment, please do so. We will do our best to ensure it gets back home with you.

## **CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS**

**Official dress will not be required. Students cannot wear any identifying information on their uniforms that would associate them with a school or technology center. Business casual is preferred.**
