



## **Internet of Things Contest Information (formerly called Residential Systems Installation)**

**\*Contest will follow national technical standards unless otherwise stated in the state memo.**

### **CONTEST FEES**

In addition to the regular conference registration, there will be a contest supplies fee of **\$25 for lunch**. This fee will be added to the contestant's registration when it is completed online.

### **CONTEST TESTING**

Written testing for most contests will be held ON-LINE through your schools' Testing Liaison.

Testing will be open beginning Monday, March 16th.

The deadline for taking the on-line tests is Friday, April 3rd.

No provisions are being made for make-up testing on-site.

**NO Substitutions will be allowed this year after March 27th**

Contest will be held Monday, April 20, 2026 at Tulsa Tech Riverside.

**Contestant Meeting will be held in the contest area at Tulsa Tech Riverside Campus, 2:00 PM on Sunday, April 19, 2026.**

### **SUPPLIED BY THE CONTESTANT**

Contestants will need to bring the following tools and materials:

Required Tools (Not to be shared among contestants):

- Safety Glasses
- Laptop Computer w/RJ-45 NIC Port (Needed to configure SOHO Device) w/ charged battery and charger
- Cordless Electric Drill and 2 batteries that are fully charged & charger
- Drill index set (Range 1/16" to 1/2") twist drill bits
- Screw Driver Set (Flat Tip, Phillips, & Torx) Sizes #1 & #2
- Nut Driver Set or SAE Hex Socket/Ratchet Set
- Torpedo level
- Tape measure 25'
- 12' to 24' 3 Prong Electrical Extension Cord
- Marking pencil to mark holes to be drilled or cutouts
- Roll of Electrical Tape (Black)
- Electrician's Scissors
- Wire Strippers (12-20 AWG and 20-26 AWG)
- Small Needle Nose Pliers
- Small Diagonal Cutters
- Linesman Pliers
- RJ-45 crimper of contestant's choice (Yes, you can bring EZ-RJ45's)



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- 110 Punch-Down Tool
- F-Type Connector Tool (similar to Ideal Tools model 35-046)
- F-Type Compression Crimper (must work with F-Type compression connector you bring)
- 2-Step Coaxial Stripping Tool
- UTP Cable Continuity Tester (for testing your Cat5e or Cat6 cables for basic continuity)
- Multi-Meter w/continuity setting or F-Type Cable Tester (for testing your RG-6 Coax cable for basic continuity)
- Contestant Wall, specs are located on page four of this document.
- Bottled Water and Snacks (It's going to be a long day and you're going to get thirsty and hungry) Lunch will be provided through registration fee.
- Band-Aids

### **CONTEST GUIDELINES**

The contest will consist of an online SkillsUSA (PDP) knowledge test, online written test covering knowledge of Home Technology Integration principles and installation of smart home devices and infrastructure.
