## **DATE AND LOCATION**

The 2026 Oklahoma SkillsUSA Quiz Bowl contest will be held Sunday, April 20th, 2026, and will be hosted at the Tulsa Downtown Doubletree Hotel, Tulsa, OK. Contestants need to report to the holding room at 12:00 noon.

### **Competition schedule**

There will be two competition rooms. Contestants will be directed to their contest rooms after check-in. The first round will begin at approximately 12:30 p.m. Instructors/Advisors will be able to attend the orientation meeting, however, only contestants may ask questions. Instructors will be asked to leave when the contest begins. **No observers will be allowed in the contest rooms.**

## **CONTEST TESTING**

Contestants will be judged on their SkillsUSA knowledge through the Professional Development test and knowledge test for contest unless otherwise state in the memo. Testing will be completed online and proctored through their technology centers. Online testing opens March 16, 2026, and closes April 3, 2026.

### **RESUME- Change to submission type please for 2025 please read**

All contestants will submit a digital resume prior to contest day. Contestants will receive an email to the address used to register the contestant for contest with instructions and link to access the SkillsUSA Competitor Portal page. The email will contain contestant username and contestant number, which are required to login to the Competitor Portal. If any contestant does not submit a resume, penalty points will be assessed.

Deadline to submit resume is April 3, 2026.

## **LUNCH**

Lunch will not be provided for this contest. Contestants will need to eat prior to contest or can purchase snack type items at the Arvest Convention Center during contest hours while not competing.

### **CONTEST CLOTHING**

Contestants will wear official SkillsUSA dress attire for contest. A clothing penalty will apply for deviations from official dress.

### **AWARDS CEREMONY**

Winners will be recognized at the General Session on Monday night, April 20th, at 7pm at the Arvest Convention Center in the Grand Hall.

**All competitors must wear official SkillsUSA dress to the Awards Session, where winners are announced. Competitors who are not dressed appropriately or lack official attire will be denied access to the awards stage. Students must be present when their contest is announced. If a student is improperly dressed, absent, or misses their contest being called, the production will not be paused for any reason, and they will forfeit their opportunity to go on stage to receive the award. No exceptions will be made. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on stage.**

- Official dress for men: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
- Official dress for women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with business like white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress Shoes.

For women: Official blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks or knee-length skirt with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, and black dress shoes.
