# EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

## Conduct & Prohibited Substances

In the event of an emergency while attending the SkillsUSA Leadership Conference, please follow these procedures:

**Fire**—Go to the nearest exit and move away from the building. Make plans ahead of time with your group to meet in a designated area to be sure everyone is accounted for. Do not re-enter the building until emergency personnel deem the area safe.

**Medical Emergency**—For minor emergencies, you can find a first aid kit in your contest area or at headquarters in the Gilcrease Room of the Tulsa Downtown Doubletree. For all other emergencies, call 911.

**Tornado**—Go to the designated areas and remain with your group until emergency personnel announce it safe to exit.

To contact state staff in SkillsUSA headquarters during the conference, dial the hotel operator at the Tulsa Downtown Doubletree (918) 587-8000 and ask for the Gilcrease Room.

After check-in, read the hotel's emergency procedures located in your sleeping room.

All participants shall abide by all local school rules, practices, and procedures. All participants shall keep the designated school personnel informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times. Individuals not officially registered with the conference will not be permitted at the hotel or in any conference area. Participants shall not use their own car or ride in cars belonging to others during the State SkillsUSA Conference unless accompanied by an authorized advisor. All participants will follow the designated conference curfew.

All participants shall attend all sessions and assigned activities. All participants are responsible for knowing their own schedules as well as being prompt and prepared for all Oklahoma SkillsUSA Conference activities. Name badges are needed for entry to all conference meetings, contests, and events. Arrangements for replacing lost name badges can be made by an advisor in SkillsUSA headquarters at the Tulsa Downtown Doubletree Hotel.

Use of tobacco or vape products is not permitted by any member or advisor while wearing official SkillsUSA attire. Use of alcoholic beverages or any controlled substance is strictly prohibited—violators are subject to immediate disciplinary action which includes being sent home immediately at the student's expense. Medals, trophies, ribbons, or certificates will not be awarded to violators.

# CONFERENCE DRESS CODE

All conference participants are expected to wear official SkillsUSA attire during General Sessions, Delegate Sessions, and Leadership Contests. Clean work clothes or official SkillsUSA attire is required for Skill Contests.

- Official attire for males is a red blazer, sweater, or windbreaker worn with white dress shirt and black tie, black trousers, and black socks/shoes.
- Official attire for females is a red blazer, sweater, or windbreaker worn with white blouse, black skirt or slacks, and black shoes. Hose is not required but if worn it must be black or clear hose.

Casual wear is permitted during recreation or free time. Avoid suggestive clothing, any clothing with suggestive wording or advertising, and other items that would reflect negatively on you, your school, or the Oklahoma SkillsUSA Association.

## **IMPORTANT**

Contest winners will be recognized during the Awards Assembly's on Monday, April 20th and Tuesday, April 21st. OFFICIAL SkillsUSA ATTIRE IS REQUIRED. In accordance with SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards, any contest winner who is not in official SkillsUSA attire will not be permitted on stage. The student will be escorted behind the stage to receive his or her medallion and/or awards. NO HATS ARE TO BE WORN DURING THE AWARDS CEREMONY.

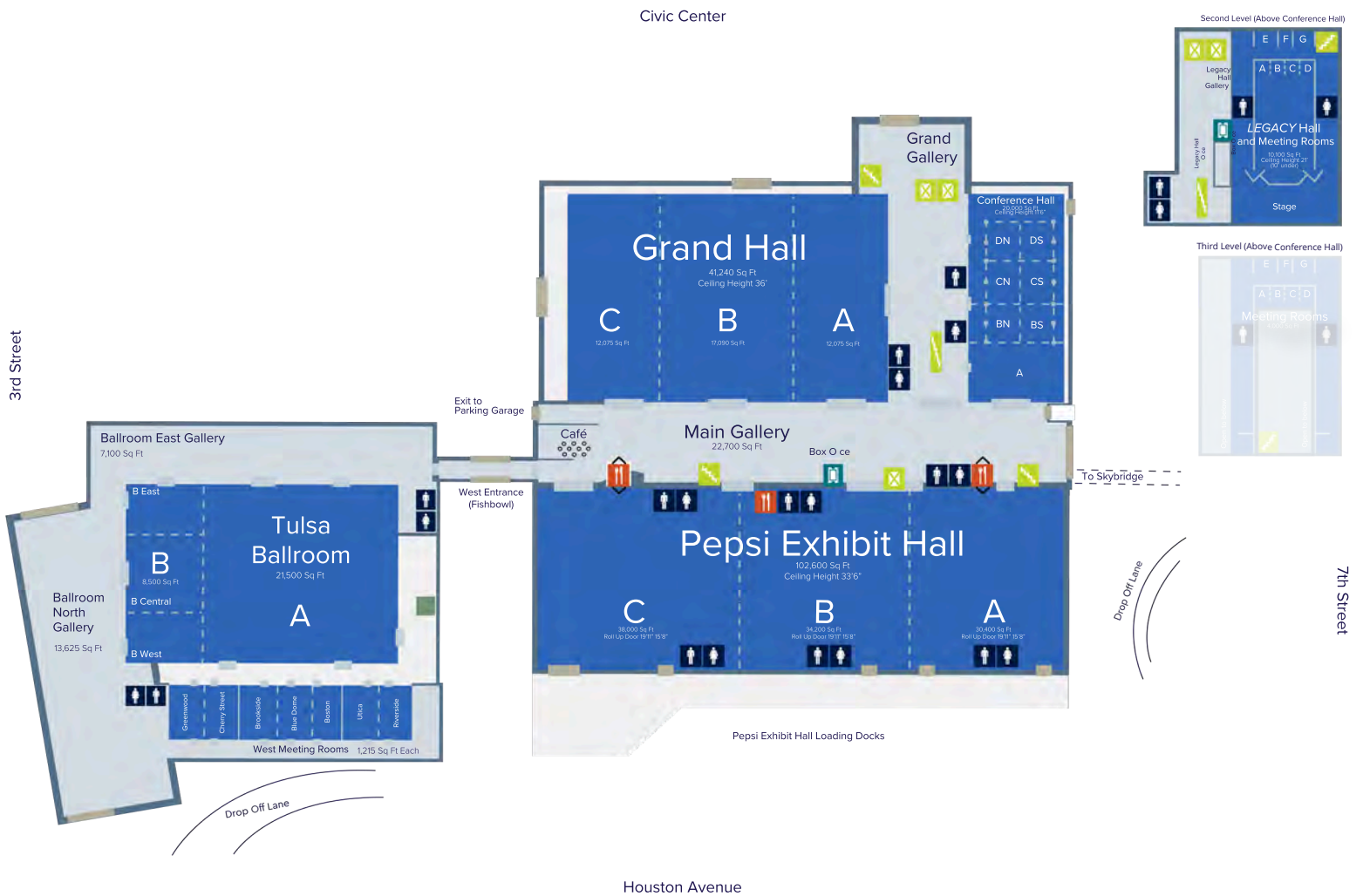

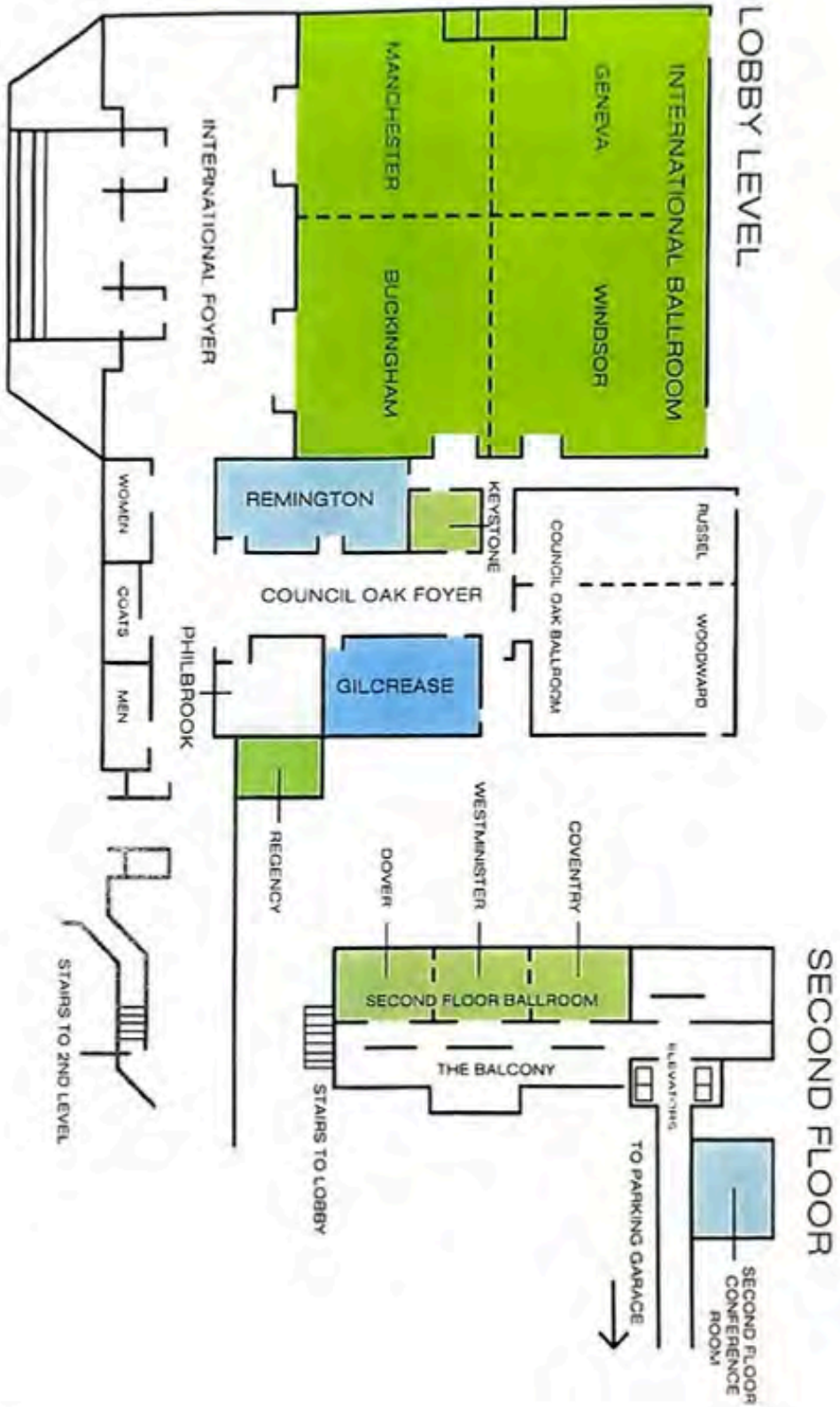

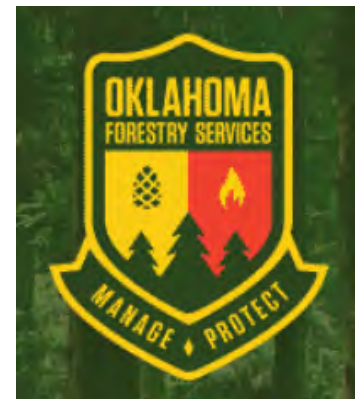
